#### Who can join?

Membership is open to adult singles and couples who have moved to the greater Venice area within 3 years and reside in one



of the following zip codes: 34275, 34292, 34293 & 34285 for at least nine months per year. Just owning a home or having a Florida driver's license is not sufficient to qualify you or your household for membership.

## How long can I be in VNC?

You can remain in VNC for three consecutive years. The club year begins in June and ends the following May. For those who join the club between January 1 and May 31, their first club year begins on June 1 of that calendar year.
